#### Changes at MBCA National

I want to let you know about some recent major changes made by the National leadership of the Mercedes-Benz Club of America.

First, National made the decision to rename "Sections" to "Chapters." No explanation was given for the name change. So we are now officially known as the Wisconsin Chapter of MBCA.

The next change, and perhaps the biggest one, was the implementation of a completely new membership database. This new database requires that all members update their membership profile to ensure that the new database is as accurate as possible. National is also proposing some major changes to the Club's organizational structure. One of those is the elimination of the Regional Directors position and replacing them with Directors at Large. Other changes are also in the works, but I don't have all the details; National is keeping a lot to themselves. We'll pass along any updates that we receive.

#### Recent Wisconsin Board Action

At their May 9th Meeting, your Board of Directors unanimously passed a resolution calling on MBCA National to

hold the annual dues at the present rate of \$85.00/year for the next three (3) years.

National plans on raising the dues next year to \$100. Your Board feels the recent increase to \$85 is sufficient.

If you have an opinion about the dues increase, I urge you to share it with me or any other board member. All comments will be forwarded to National leadership, but we reserve the right to edit comments for brevity and content.

### The Art and Science of Detailing: Making that Mercedes-Benz Shine! Recap

#### A Detailing Clinic by Ricardo Becerra and Jerry Zajicek

About 30 plus members showed up for a 2 hour discussion on the latest products and techniques in automotive detailing. Ricardo's focus has lately been on efficient detailing of approximately 20 to 30 cars per week for the Waukesha area dealers. My focus lately has been on new products, and new techniques to make detailing easier, quicker, and better with a minimum of effort and money. Overall appearance quality has been my goal as I've done over 80 cars in the last 20 years.

We talked about the new trend of SiO2 infused products, which chemical manufacturers have now added to almost all products across their product lines. SiO2 generally acts as a glossing agent, and it's been added to waxes, sealants, tire coatings, interior dressings and the like. Graphene is the next such additive that manufacturers are using, not only because it glosses more, but it costs more too. And we talked about the proper way to apply Graphene products, spraying the applicator instead of the panel you are shining....

A major focus of prepping a car for waxing (or applying sealant) is getting the car very clean via the wet wash with one or two buckets, the rinseless wash, or waterless washes. After washing and rinsing with RO water, decontamination may be necessary for the removal of Iron spots, road film, old wax, bugs, etc. There are several manufacturers of detail chemicals that now supply Iron re-mover, bug remover, and fallout remover to aide in the decon process.

Lastly we finished up with a few questions on interior cleaning, and I highlighted the use of Interior Detailers, a new product classification for maintenance cleaning, as opposed to Interior Cleaners, which are more intended for removal of spots and stains, heavy buildup and far dirtier areas.

Last, but not least, Laura Becerra arranged a wonderful table of foods for everyone to enjoy. Cold drinks, Mexican food (home made) and desserts, hit the spot for everyone..... Thank You Laura for the Welcome to Leon International Auto Detailing, the Becerra family company. It was greatly appreciated.

### Fall Color Tour Oct 18-20, 2024

Join us on this fall color tour, exploring the many sights along WI Hwy 33. We will start our tour in Port Washington, exploring the area on Friday, Oct 18. An overnight stay is optional for those who may desire to do so. Todd Knutson, who lives near Port Washington, will provide more details on this in our next newsletter

Saturday, we will drive west on Hwy 33 thru West Bend, Beaver Dam, Portage, Baraboo, Reedsburg, etc to LaCrosse. See attached map and website link to Hwy 33 drive.

This entire driving tour is self-guided and paced. You can join us anywhere along this route. We are not driving as a group. Lunch is on your own time and choice.

West of Reedsburg, is the most hilly and scenic part of Hwy 33, with over 10 miles of Amish farmlands to Cashton (see attached photos and info on driving this area). Drive at your own pace, stopping where you want, to see things of interest to you.

When you arrive in LaCrosse, Hwy 33 ends. You should explore sights in this area, esp driving up to the top of 500 feet high Grandad's Bluff Park, which offers incredible views for miles of LaCrosse and the Mississippi River.

We will recommend a hotel (TBA) for our group to stay at Saturday night in the LaCrosse area.

Sunday, you may want to continue your driving adventure by exploring the Great River Road on both WI Hwy 35 and MN Hwy 61 between LaCrosse, Lake Pepin and Red Wing. There is much to see and do along both of these scenic river roads. The total drive time is 3-4 hours. You may want to return to further explore more of this scenic area in future trips.


You can also drive about an hour south of LaCrosse on WI Hwy 35 to explore Prairie du Chien. Or just drive directly back home if you desire.
