

If you have not already visited and established your new MBCA member account, please do so now.

- Every member should have received an email on March 13, inviting you to establish your account and a new password.
- What if you didn't get that email or put the email in your trash? Simply go to **mbca.org** and click on **Register** and proceed with your email address. Disregard the suggestion of using your phone number instead. (If you get a message that your email address already exists, then click on **Login**, and then click on the **Forgot Password** link to set your password.) Agree to the terms by checking the box. Click on **Continue**. Create a Password: minimum of 8 letters including one uppercase, one lower-case, one number, and one special character.
- Once logged into the website: then click on Create Account, and fill in the boxes.
- Click on **PROFILE**, complete your profile, (if you are comfortable with it, tell us more about your interests and the cars in your garage.) You don't have to join Linkedin, X, etc., unless you want to.
- When finished filling in the form, click Create Account.
- Now that you are "in", click on **GO to My Glue Home** to explore "Your Chapter Community", interact with your Chapter Community, stay informed with upcoming Events.
- Explore the Mercedes-Benz Club of America on the website. Switch "organizations" by clicking on the **blue circle with your** initials, then **Switch Organizations** to the **Mercedes-Benz Club of America**.
