I'm having a great time being section president. Thank you for supporting me, and please know that I think you guys are the greatest. It is still an honor.



#### THE WILD AND WACKY WORLD OF EXOTIC CARS

It's been a while since we gathered here to gaze into the wild world of exotic cars. Well, the mantra of too much is never enough continues. The world of exotics knows no bounds, especially when it comes to prices and horsepower. Let's look at a few.

First up – We have Aston Martin, who introduced the new DB12 last year. Interestingly enough, the 12 in the name is ironic as Aston has dropped its V12 engine for the 4-liter, twin turbo V8 sourced from Mercedes-Benz. That engine is now putting out 671 hp in the DB12 backed by an eight-speed automatic. The car is available as either a coupe or convertible. With a base price of around \$250k for the coupe and \$265k for the convertible. Let me be clear that for these and the next few cars we will discuss there is no such thing as buying one for base price. Even without dealer markups, the options list can easily add 10 to 20% to the base price. For those with fearless bank accounts, you can add quite a bit more. The next new Aston is the Vantage which is new for 2025. It sports the same 4-liter twin turbo as the DB12. Power output here is 656 hp. Both cars are capable of 0-60 times in the 3.5 second range with a top speed over 200 mph. The Vantage is available as a coupe or convertible with base prices slightly less than the DB12. I haven't driven either one yet, but I will let you know when I do.

Not to be outdone by Aston or anyone else for that matter, Ferrari has introduced its latest V-12 cars. Named, appropriately enough, the 12Cilindri is available as a coupe or a spyder. The car is the replacement for the 812 model. In this latest iteration of the V-12, the engine produces 830 hp at 9500 rpm from its 6.5-

liter, V-12 without the aid of any turbos or hybrid electrics. Ferrari claims a 0-60 time of less than 3 seconds and a top speed of nearly 215 mph. Base price is irrelevant in the \$500k range because unless you are privileged enough to already have one on order you can't buy one anyway. Delivered prices will probably run in the \$700-\$800k range. On the entry level part of the range, Ferrari still offers the Roma in coupe and spyder form starting at around \$300k. The Roma is a nice diversion for the wife to drive when she is not taking the kids to school in her \$500k Ferrari SUV, the Purosangue.

On a much lower price point but of interest, Porsche has decided to go full EV on the Boxter, Cayman and Macan SUV series of cars. 2024 is the last year you can buy dinosaur versions of these cars. If you want an internal combustion engine version, you need to get to your Porsche dealer now. The Macan comes in two versions, the 4 with 402 hp and the ironically named Turbo which has 630 hp with no turbos. Both cars are full EV. They are not hybrids. Base prices will be in the \$70k range for the 4 and \$90k range for the turbo.


