Updated — Fall Color Tour Oct 19-20, 2024

Join us on this fall color tour, Oct 19-20, exploring the many sights along WI Hwy 33 and the Great Mississippi River Road.

The starting point for our driving tour on Saturday will be the Log Cabin Restaurant located on Hwy 33 as you enter east Baraboo. Plan to arrive there between 10:00-11:00 AM to enjoy a late breakfast or lunch.

Depart on the fall color drive when you are ready, in small groups or single MB cars. This entire driving tour is self-guided and paced. Procede west on Hwy 33 to Reedsburg. West of Reedsburg, is the most hilly and scenic part of Hwy 33, with over 10 miles of Amish farms located between Ontario to Cashton (see attached photos and info on driving this area). Drive at your own pace, stopping where you want, to see things of interest to you.

When you arrive in LaCrosse, Hwy 33 ends. You should explore sights in this area, esp driving up to the top of 500 feet elevation Grandad's Bluff Park, which offers incredible views for miles of LaCrosse and the Mississippi River. The Dahl Auto Museum on Hwy 35 near downtown LaCrosse is also interesting to see. It closes at 4:00 pm on Saturday. Allow at least half an hour to tour this museum.

Lodging and dinner in LaCrosse--

We have reserved a variety of 30 hotel rooms for \$149/double or single occupancy at the Gundersen Hotel & Suites (608-793-0200) under the "MBCA" name. Check in time starts after 3:00 pm. Recommend that you reserve a room soon if you are considering participating in this popular fall color driving tour. This is a peak fall color weekend in LaCrosse, so many area hotels are already booked.

We have requested 25 booklets on the WI Great River Road and the LaCrosse area from the LaCrosse visitors bureau be dropped off at the hotel for our members. We also have free use of a hotel meeting room for our group in the evening.

We have also made a group dinner reservation at 5:30 pm for up to 40 of our MBCA participants at the Freight House Restaurant in nearby downtown La-Crosse (<u>www.freighthouserestaurant.com</u>).

Sunday, you may want to continue your driving adventure by exploring the Great River Road on both WI Hwy 35 and MN Hwy 61 between LaCrosse, Lake Pepin and Red Wing. There is much to see and do along both of these scenic river roads. The total drive time is 3-4 hours. You may want to return to further explore more of this scenic area in future trips.

You can also drive about an hour south of LaCrosse on WI Hwy 35 to explore Prairie du Chien. Or just drive directly back home if you desire.



All refunds will be made via a check mailed by the Section Treasurer to the member at their address of record as shown on the Membership Roster as maintained by the MBCA National office.
