Middle of Nowhere!

On the partly cloudy morning of August 18, 2024, under the threat of an impending thunderstorm, ten adventurous teams set out on a scenic road rally through the countryside. Organized by the MBCA Niagara Chapter, the teams began the mapped-out course in the parking lot of Lockmaster in Orchard Park and worked their way through the picturesque rural towns and villages of East Aurora, Java, Eagle, Pike, Nunda and Canaseraga before reaching the tiny Hamlet of Birdsall, NY and the Birdsall Inn.

The road rally teams left the starting point at 8-minute intervals after being given a set of instructions with step-by-step directions detailing the route to be followed. A road rally is a competition that takes place on public roads in which teams compete to complete the course with the most precision. Each team has a driver and a navigator. The driver is tasked with driving at a steady pace in line with the speed limit and following the turn-by-turn directions as presented by the navigator. The navigator delivers directions to the driver, calculates times, spots landmarks and answers questions about various items seen along the route.

This rally was planned over at least 6 trial runs by the Longs and Gaffneys. It's possible that these "rally masters" had more fun than anyone while fine tuning the directions and landmark questions. The rally route took under two hours to complete and led to a great little tavern/restaurant named the Birdsall Inn, whose sign greeted our teams with their slogan "Welcome to the Middle of Nowhere".

Joanie and Gene Long logged each team's arrival and calculated the points totals. All of the participants arrived safely, some with greater ease than others. Everyone raved about the beautiful scenery and really enjoyed the destination establishment's food, drink and great staff. It's owner, "Birdsall Bob" Stachura made a point of being on hand for our arrival and insisted on gifting an eight pack of their house ale to the winning team!

The picturesque drive and the Birdsall Inn were such a popular success that several members requested that the club make a casual return trip to enjoy the fall foliage and the hospitality at our
