Located near the SE corner intersection of Interstate I-135 & 61st North St, Park City, KS

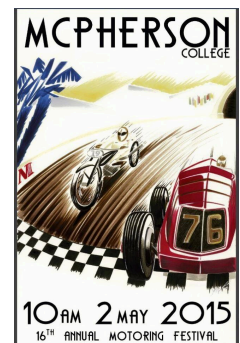

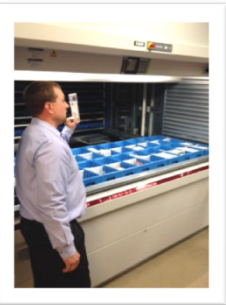

The Wichita Luxury Collection, Mercedes-Benz of Wichita hosted a fun and informative tech session for the Wichita Section. 17 members attended this event that was lead by the Marketing Director, Melody Matulewic.



Sales manager, Shahab Namdar, presented a brand new 2015 S550 Coupe, covering many of the new technical innovations, i.e., a heads up display, a shade transitioning moon roof, a 360 degree camera system, and driver assist/collision avoidance/cruise control features all tied to a sophisticated radar system in the car. Shahab fielded numerous questions from the group regarding both mechanical and technical features in the

car.

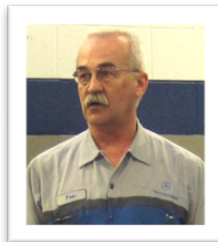


Parts manager, Stuart Sherre, showed us their state of art robotic parts bin system which stores around 85% of the dealership's parts inventory in a very small footprint. This frees up space in the service area and allows for automated parts inventory.



Tom Sincissen, a Mercedes-Benz Master Technician in the service area

gave us a behind the scenes look at all the work that is done on a previously owned Mercedes-Benz before it is designated as a Certified Pre-Owned vehicle. He showed us the extensive Mercedes-Benz service record system that is tied into all previously service records of a car done at any Mercedes-Benz dealership across the county. Tom also discussed the type of diagnostic test reports and service records that can be run on any 1996 and later vehicle and also answered several maintenance questions from the group.



We were also invited to see a 2016 AMG GT S Coupe that was stopping at their AMG dealership for 90 minutes the following Monday to give the staff an up close look. Several members did come by and enjoy the opportunity to view. It was white and just like the car shown on the back cover of the Mar/Apr 2015 issue of The Star magazine and the spring raffle's grand prize.

It was a great day at the dealership!

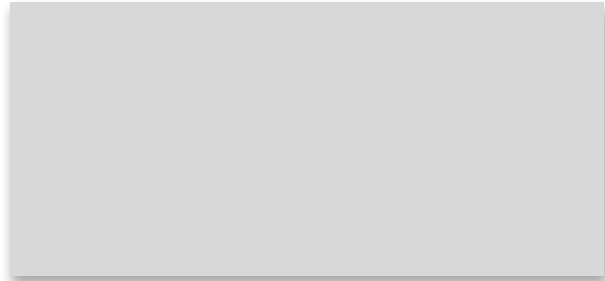
