McPherson College | C.A.R.S. Club 17th Annual Car & Motorcycle Show & 2nd Annual Swap Meet

Saturday, April 30, 2016 10am – 4pm McPherson College | McPherson, KS

Location: McPherson College | 1600 E. Euclid | McPherson, KS (center lawn)

Times: Car show registration/parking <u>8am-10:00am</u> and Awards begin <u>3pm</u>

Caravan: 9:00am sharp leaving from back parking lot of Cracker Barrel Restaurant, (optional) Park City, KS (I-135 & North 61st St) or meet us at the show.

Registration Directions: From Interstate I-135 & Hwy US 56 (State Ave) in

McPherson, drive west 1 mile on US 56 and over railroad bridge; turn north for 1 block on Eby; then turn east along Baer St. for 3 blocks as it curves north; then turn west on Euclid St. and proceed west half block to registration tent.

The car show is completely organized and run by students enrolled in the Automotive Restoration program at McPherson College, the only school in the United States to offer a Bachelor's Degree in the restoration of antique and classic collector vehicles.

At the national level, the Mercedes-Benz Club of America (MBCA) is a strong supporter of McPherson College restoration program. And for many years, MBCA club members from the surrounding states have shown their support by participating in the show by entering their Mercedes-Benz classics, to-be classics, and brand new

Mercedes-Benz. The Mercedes-Benz vehicles will be judged in the Foreign Class category and will be parked all in one area. All models and years of Mercedes-Benz are encouraged to enter! It's free to attend the show and also during the show, it's free to go thru the guided tours of the auto restoration department facility. You can also see students demonstrate how to assemble in less than 20 minutes a Ford Model T from just parts.

The students will have several feature vehicles this year. One particularly unique one will be a concept car called the Manta Ray. 
