Herb and three other men, as well as many military personnel, were sent to the Mediterranean to help locate the bombs. Multiple books and even a 2000 movie, "Men of Honor" tell the story of this historic "Broken Arrow" incident.

Herb is the proud owner of a 1992 300E Mercedes. It was purchased new in Beverly Hills, and somehow made its way to Kansas. Herb bought it from a local dealer here about five years ago. The car is in excellent condition with over 170,000 miles on it. The only repair he's done is to replace the starter motor. He's been a member of MBCA for 4 years.



When asked why he chose a Mercedes, Herb replied that he wanted a rear wheel drive car with a 50% balance like BMW, spotless, and no damage. Herb said his previous cars were BMW and Alfa Romeo, thus giving us an idea of his high quality requirements.
