Visit to United Engine Specialists, Saturday March 12th



OFFICIAL RULES. PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.

- You must be 18 years of age or older, a U.S. citizen and a current Member of the Mercedes-Benz Club of America (MBCA) to purchase tickets.
- 2. You must be a current Member at the time of the drawing to be eligible to win.
- Credit and debit cards accepted. Payments made by check/money order must be in U.S. funds. Checks must be exclusively for the payment of the ticket(s) and not include other purchases or renewal payments.
- Void where prohibited by law.
- An Official Order form, or copy thereof, must be used to purchase tickets when ordering by mail. Order forms have been mailed to members and are also available upon request from the National Business Office (NBO) or at www.mbca.org. Mail order form requests to: Raffle, 1907 Lelaray Street, Colorado Springs, CO 80909.
- Ticket orders must be received no later than June 16, 2022. Ticket orders and checks arriving after June 16, 2022 will be returned to sender.
- 7. All ticket sales are final at the time of purchase. There are no refunds.
- 8. Tickets will only be issued in the name of the Primary Member listed in the MBCA membership files and does not include Associate Members. Prizes will be awarded on the same basis. Winning tickets cannot be assigned, transferred or sold. Membership must be current at the time of purchasing a ticket(s) and at the time of the drawing.
- 9. Paid staff, contractors of MBCA and The Star® magazine, their immediate families and household members may not participate in the Raffle.
- 10. Odds of winning will be based on the number of tickets sold.
- Prize winners must complete a form from the NBO and return it within 45 days of the mailing of written notification of winning.
- 12. The drawing will be held and certified at 5754 South Dundas Road, Beaverton, MI 48612 at 10:30 a.m. ET on June 23, 2022. Any MBCA member may attend the drawing; attendance is not required to win. Results will be posted at www.mbca.org.
- 13. The raffle is sponsored by MBCA, International Stars Section and ticket requests are subject to its acceptance. This Raffle is licensed under the laws of the State of Michigan. License Number R63718.
- 14. A minimum of 4,225 tickets MUST BE SOLD to award prizes. 1st place winner will receive \$95,570 less 24% tax-withholdings; 2nd place winner will receive \$10,000 less 24% tax-withholdings. The 1st prize winner may shop for their vehicle at the dealership of their choice. The 2nd prize winner will receive a check that may be applied towards 2022 Mercedes-Benz Club of America, Inc. National Event (subject to availability). If fewer than 4,225 tickets are sold, 1st prize winner will receive 90% of one-half (50%) of the gross raffle ticket sales; and 2nd prize winner will receive 10% of one-half (50%) of the gross raffle ticket sales. Less Federal withholding of 24%, or the shared prizes of \$5,000 (less withholding), whichever is greater. The 90% 1st prize and 10% 2nd prize will be paid directly to the winner. MBCA's German Trips Have Returned!

Choose from one of four space-limited trips that have been scheduled for this 2022 year!

- July 11 to 17, 2022
- July 18 to 24, 2022
- September 5 to 11, 2022
- September 12 to 18, 2022

Each trip includes six hotel nights, six breakfasts, six dinners, and four lunches. Travel by chartered deluxe coach, admissions and taxes, hotel and restaurant gratuities, English-speaking Mercedes-Benz host, and an MBCA host are also included. Airfare and personal expenses such as alcohol and souvenirs are not included.

Cost: \$3,000 per person. A nonrefundable \$500 deposit per person is required upon registering for a German Trip. An additional 10% supplement fee is required for single travelers.

Understandably, the German Trips are contingent upon COVID-related circumstances, which are subject to change at any time.

Trip participants must carry and present proof of vaccination and any required boosters in addition to requirements by Governments for travelers to/from or within their countries. Face masks may be required at any or all venues. MBCA may cancel the German Trips for any unforeseen reasons.
