# Mercedes-Benz New Nomenclature, starting in 2015 (<a href="http://www.emercedesbenz.com">http://www.emercedesbenz.com</a>)

- For a simple and transparent way to identify the growing portfolio of models and with different body variants and drive systems. - The model designation will always be an acronym made up of between one to three uppercase letters. The system centers around the five core model class series, A, B, C, E and S, which will continue to be used. The "L" is a linking letter that makes the model designations easier to remember and pronounce. The third letter will indicate the relationship to the relevant core model class series. The engine type will be indicated by a lower-case letter.

#### New SUV (GL):

GLA (GL A-Class)

GLC (GL C-Class); previously GLK

GLE (GL E-Class); previously M-Class or ML

GLE Coupé (GL E-Class Coupé) (available late summer 2015)

GLS (GL S-Class); previously GL

G unchanged because of iconic status

#### 4-door Coupés (CL):

CLA (CL A-Class)

CLS (CL S-Class)

Roasters (SL):

SLC (SL C-Class); previously SLK (starting 2016)

SL unchanged because of iconic status

#### **Engine Types (lower-case letter):**

c "compressed natural gas" (Natural Gas Drive until now)

d "diesel" (BlueTEC and CDI until now)

e "electric" (PLUG-IN HYBRID, BlueTEC PLUG-IN HYBRID, & Electric Drive until now)

f "fuel cell" (F-CELL until now)

h "hybrid" (HYBRID and BlueTEC HYBRID until now)

All-wheel-drive:

4MATIC unchanged
